Gift Aid Declaration notes:

1. It was confirmed on 24th March 1964 by the Legal Branch of the Ministry of Education that under the powers granted to the Minister of Education under section 2 of the Charities Act 1960, the Oxford University Boat Club Trust (the Trust) was regarded as charitable and that registration as a charity was unnecessary in view of the exempting provisions of paragraph (e) of the second schedule to the Charities Act 1960. The Trust is recognized by the Inland Revenue as having charitable status and for that purpose has been assigned reference number X 85421 A. The Trust Deed empowers the Trustees to provide support to any activity that they deem to be in the interests of rowing at Oxford. Whilst they will note any suggestions made by donors, they reserve the absolute right to exercise their discretion as to how donations are applied.
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity, Oxford University Boat Club Trust, The Office, Weald Manor, Bampton, Oxfordshire OX18 2HQ, England.
3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give). If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
5. If you are unsure of whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.
